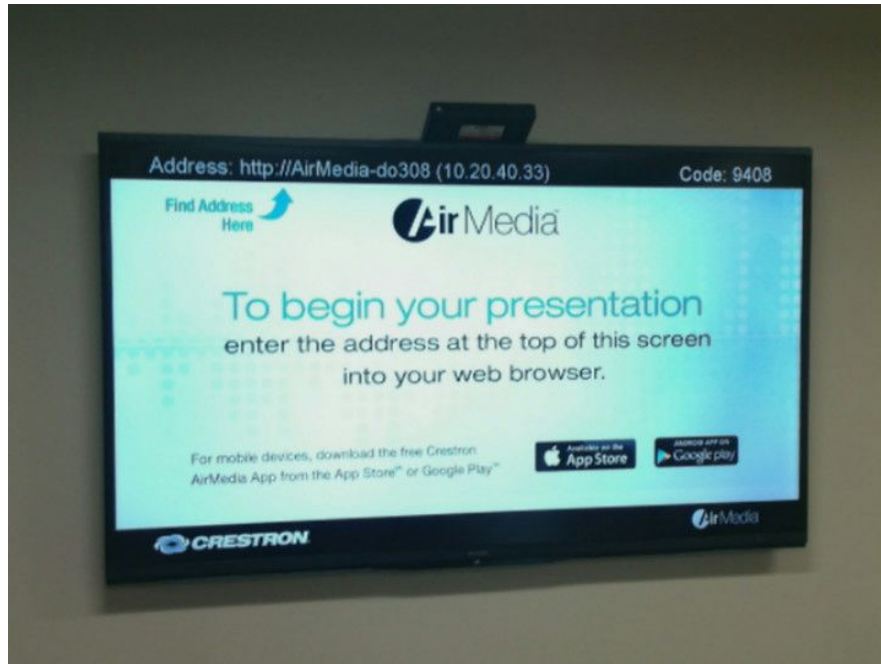
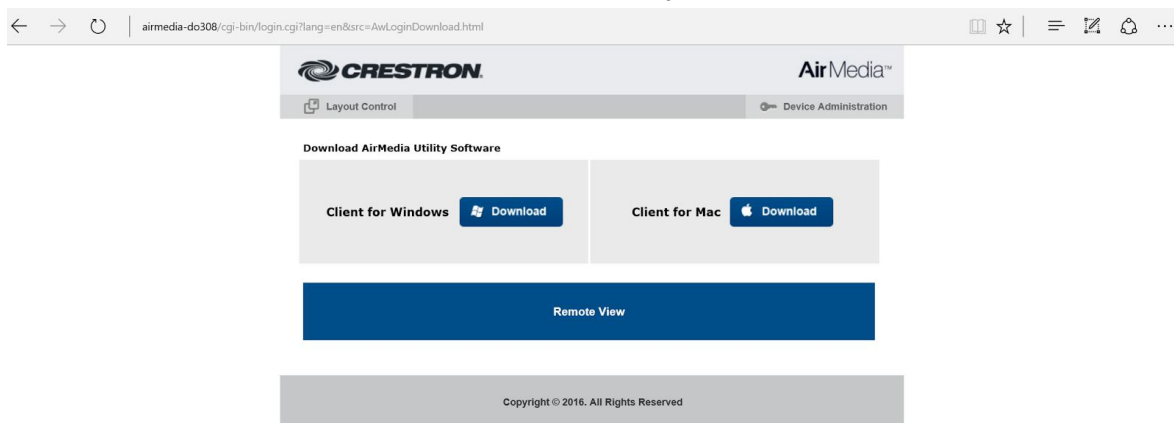


How to use AirMedia with a PC/Mac

1. Turn on the TV
2. Change the input to 'HDMI' with the remote
3. An AirMedia screen will show (see picture)



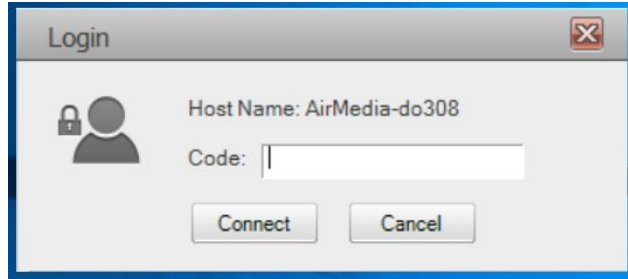
4. Put the address at the top of the TV screen in your browser



5. Download the AirMedia Utility Software from the link provided. This will be dependent on your computer (Windows/Mac)
6. Once finished downloading, run the .exe/.dmg file

Note: Macs may need to take extra steps to use sound (extra steps provided later in document)


7. You will be prompted to enter a code. This is located at the top right of your TV.
Once you hit connect, your screen will begin streaming to the TV

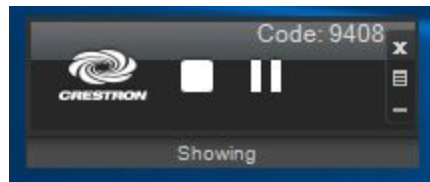


8. Your screen is now streaming to the TV. The AirMedia window that pops up can be used for controls:

a. Pause/Play 

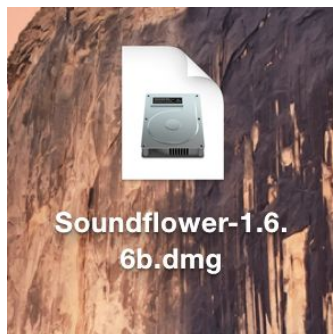
b. Freeze/Resume 

c. (Top to bottom) Close, Settings, Minimize 



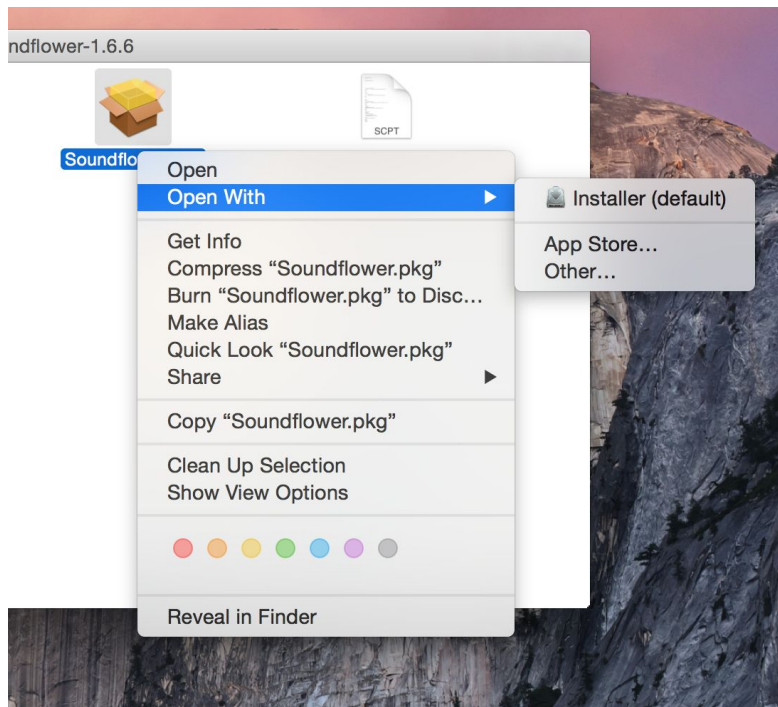
How to use sound on a Mac with AirMedia

1. In order to use sound on your Mac, you may need to download and install SoundFlower <http://soundflower.en.softonic.com/mac>
2. Download and run the .dmg file



3. You will see a folder of files

4. Hold down the command key and click the soundflower.pkg file

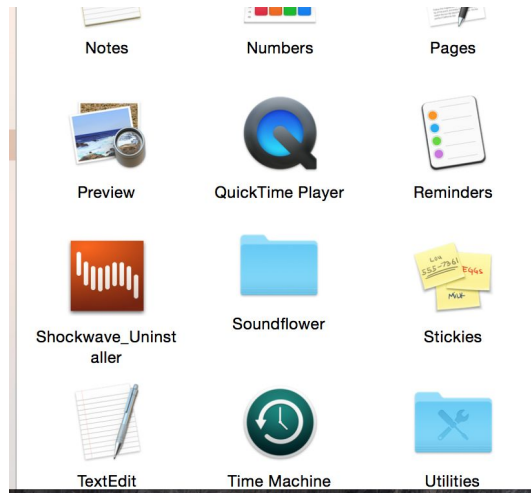


5. Open with 'Installer' (hit 'Open' if this prompt appears)

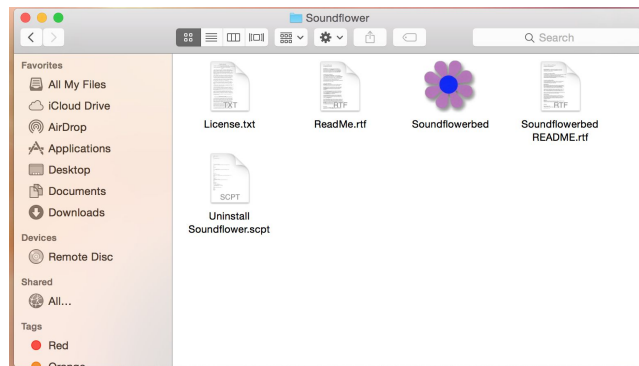


6. Continue through the install wizard and accept/continue and prompts
7. You will need to restart your system

8. Navigate to 'Applications' and find the 'Soundflower' folder



9. Open the folder and open the file with the flower icon named 'Soundflowerbed'



10. There will now be a flower icon in the top right of your screen



11. Sound will now transmit through AirMedia
