Long Range Facilities Planning Committee

Planning Charter

The Long Range Facilities Planning Committee is charged to study, report findings, and make recommendations for a long range school facilities plan for the Monona Grove School District. The following are issues for the Committee's working agenda.

1. Expected student population growth in the Monona Grove School District (MGSD) and at each grade in the MGSD
2. Capacity of each school in the MGSD
3. Anticipated maintenance and repair for all schools in the MGSD
4. Flexible space requirements for 21st Century learning needs
5. Modifications, remodeling, improvements, upgrades, and/or additions to schools, including athletic facilities at MGHS
6. Location and land acquisition for the future construction of schools in the MGSD
7. Use and/or sale of (a) residential property adjacent to MGHS, (b) a parcel of land on Pheasant Hill Road in Monona, and (c) residential property across from GDS on Damascus Road that is currently owned by the MGSD
8. Future use of Nichols School that is currently shared with MG21 and the Dane County Consortium of Schools and Maywood School that is currently leased to the Madison Public Schools.
9. Elementary school grade alignments that are currently PK-1 at Taylor Prairie School, 2-4 at Cottage Grove School, and 5 at GDS, and PreK-5 at Winnequah School in Monona
10. Operational costs of any new facilities or grade alignments

The Committee will discuss this working agenda at our first meeting. I am sure that an additional item or two may emerge during the course of our work. However, if you have any items for our working agenda, please bring them to our first meeting for discussion.

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
