

## What is PBIS?

- A broad range of proactive, systematic and individualized strategies to promote academic achievement and behavioral competence
- Teaches the expectations for appropriate behavior in all areas of the school environment
- Uses common language, while focusing on three key behavior expectations:

Safe

Respectful

Responsible



## Why is it important for families to be involved?

When families are involved, children....

- ◆ Exhibit more positive attitudes and behaviors
- ◆ Report increased self-confidence
- ◆ Demonstrate better school outcomes
- ◆ Feel school is important and valuable

The most accurate prediction of school success is not income or social status, but the extent to which the student's family is able to create a home environment that encourages learning and involvement in children's education at school and in the community.
