

2023 OPERATIONAL REFERENDUM

Monona Grove students learn in a safe environment and are deeply cared for.

This proposed referendum would:

Preserve and maintain what we have today:

- Keep teachers and staff at the levels they are now, and offer more competitive pay in order to attract and retain the high-quality teachers and staff our students deserve and our community values.
- **Keep student support** services and programs as they are now.
- **Keep class sizes** where they are now.

Provide stability for district planning and for residents

- The majority of our costs are ongoing (staffing, transportation, utilities). A recurring referendum allows the school district to incorporate **long-term fiscal plans** in the budgeting process.
- Projections show **stability** in the tax rate for our community over the long term.

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If the referendum is not approved on April 4, immediate action will be needed to address the \$6 million deficit in the budget beginning July 1, 2023. We will need to make cuts to our largest expenses, including staffing.
